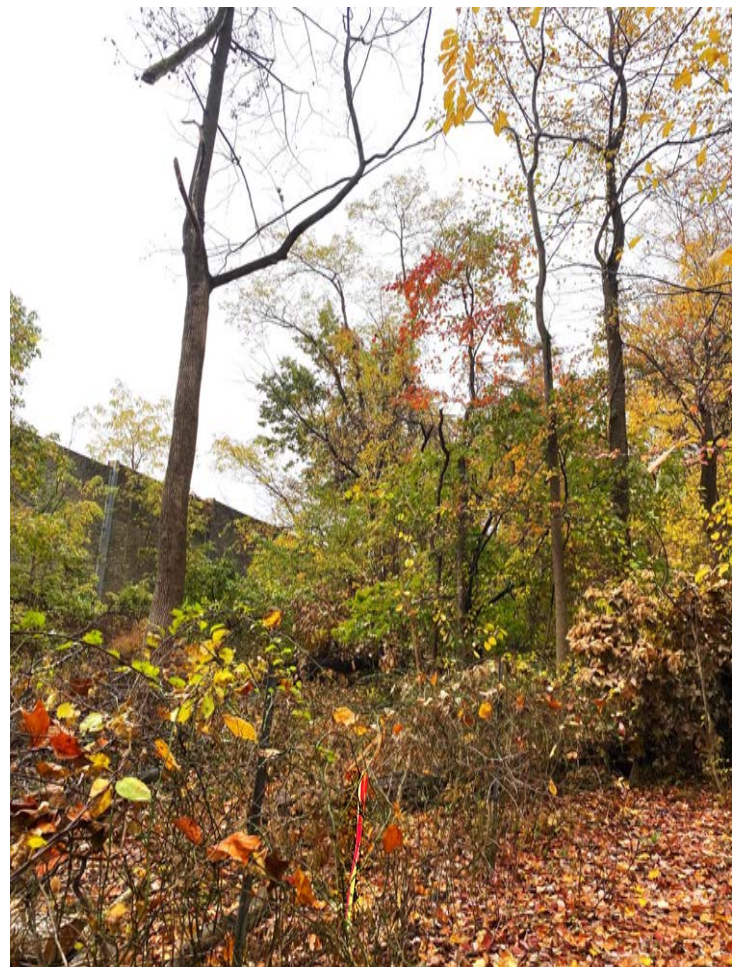
Near Northbound I-495 Noise Wall Between
Old Dominion Drive and Georgetown Pike

Tree Clearing to Start on or about November 14

I-495 Express Lanes Northern Extension (495 NEXT) Project

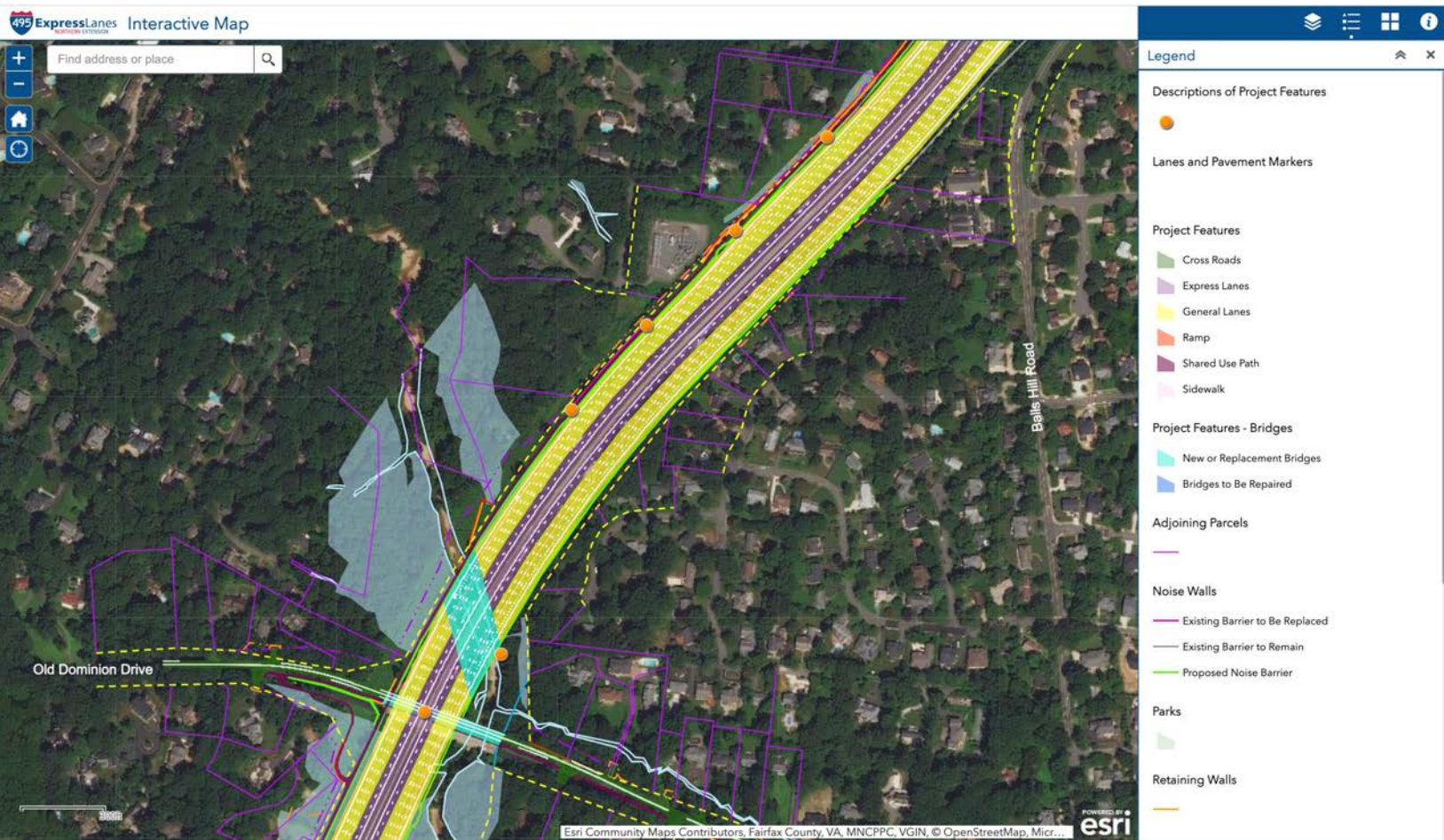
Beginning on or about November 14, tree clearing will occur on the neighborhood side of the noise wall along northbound I-495 between Old Dominion Drive and Georgetown Pike. This area is adjacent to residences located on portions of Churchill Road and Delf Road as well as McLean Presbyterian Church on Balls Hill Road. Tree clearing is necessary in this area to make room for the widened footprint of I-495 and to demolish and build new noise walls. This work is planned to occur within VDOT right of way.
