### Northern Virginia Express Lanes

- Additional capacity and congestion relief
- New faster and more reliable travel options
- Dynamic system
   with variable tolls to
   manage demand and
   keep lanes free
   flowing for all
   express lanes users
- Moves more people, not just vehicles



#### **Express Lanes Drivers**

Vehicles with fewer than 3 people can choose to use the express lanes by paying a toll, receiving a faster and more reliable trip.



#### **HOV-3+ and Motorcycles Travel Toll Free**

Carpools with 3 or more occupants, and motorcycles, can travel the express lanes for free anytime.



#### **Buses Travel Toll Free**

Faster and more reliable travel creates new opportunities and benefits for buses (who travel for free) on express lanes.



#### **Funding Support for Enhanced Transit in Corridors**

Transit payments in project agreements allow toll revenues to fund transit and multimodal improvements.



#### Transit & Multimodal Elements Included in Project Scope


Transit and multimodal features such as new commuter parking lots, shared-use paths and bus service can be incorporated into project scopes.





### 495 Express Lanes Northern Extension Project (495 NEXT)

- Approx. \$660 million, 2.5-mile extension of 495 Express Lanes from Dulles Corridor interchange to George Washington Memorial Parkway (GWMP) near the American Legion Bridge
- Public-private partnership project between VDOT and Transurban through 2087
- Express Lanes scheduled to open late 2025
- Project completion in mid-2026







### 495 NEXT Project Benefits

### 2025 Benefits Independent of Maryland Project

- Moves more people
- Provides time savings for express lanes users during peak periods
- Reduces cut-through traffic on local roads
- Improves safety and operations
  - New direct access ramps to express lanes at DTR and George Washington Memorial Parkway interchanges, eliminating merge across four lanes to access express lanes
  - New roadway features, such as increased acceleration and deceleration lanes, and new auxiliary lanes

### **Environmental Commitments**

- Transurban provided \$1.387M to Fairfax County for restoring approximately 3,000 linear feet of Scott's Run
- Stabilize stream banks at two locations along Scott's Run



#### Fairfax County Park Authority Replacement Land

- Create parking and trail connection to Scott's Run and new bike and pedestrian shared-use path
- VDOT Maintenance Yard with privacy fence next to park








### Bicycle and Pedestrian Shared-Use Path

- Design coordinated with Fairfax County to advance county bike plan
- Shared-use path added along I-495 corridor
  - Shared-use path behind the noise wall between Lewinsville Road and Live Oak Drive
  - Connection to future crossing at American Legion Bridge to Maryland
- New and improved bike and pedestrian facilities on bridges over I-495
  - Old Dominion Drive (VA 783)
  - Georgetown Pike (VA 193)
  - Live Oak Drive
  - Lewinsville Road
- Completion of shared-use path and new Scott's Run Nature Preserve parking lot: early 2026









### **Overall Construction Schedule**

- Started construction: March 2022
- Remove noise walls and clear trees to widen Beltway: late 2022-early 2024
- Install drainage, perform earthwork, construct new lanes outside current I-495 alignment: 2023-2024
- Shift traffic to outside lanes to enable construction of inside lanes: late 2024early 2025
- Open Express Lanes: late 2025
- Complete overall project: mid 2026

## I-495 (Capital Beltway) Traffic Shift

Shift traffic to outside lanes to enable construction of inside, future express lanes in late 2024-early 2025




### 495 NEXT Work Zone Safety



April 15 - 19, 2024

- 2.5-mile active construction zone
- Work activities occurring during day and nighttime hours
- Constrained area with reduced shoulders, lane closures and traffic shifts
- Keeping workers and drivers safe is everyone's responsibility
- Slow down, use caution and stay alert

### **Bridge Construction Work**

# Replace old bridges with upgraded new bridges featuring wider sidewalks and trail connections

- Drive piles, complete abutments: early-mid 2024
- Lift and place bridge girders:
  - Georgetown Pike: late March-early April
  - Live Oak Drive: early-mid April
  - Old Dominion Drive: fall 2024
- Install deck, barriers, signage and lane markings:
  mid-late 2024
- Switch traffic onto new bridges, demolish old bridges:
  late 2024-early 2025

### **Live Oak Drive Remaining Construction**

- Complete waterline and drainage work where the alignment of a short stretch of Live Oak Drive will be shifted
- Perform earthwork to level the area
- Install road foundation, pave and mark new length of Live Oak Drive
- Switch traffic: mid May 2024
- Demolish remaining walls and retired pavement
- Construct retaining walls to enable GW Memorial Parkway ramps to be built

### Noise Wall Progress

# Noise wall construction: early 2023-early 2025

#### **Progress as of March 2024:**

- More than 90 sections of new noise wall installed on northbound I-495 between Old Dominion Drive and Georgetown Pike
- More than 130 noise wall posts mounted between Old Dominion Drive and Live Oak Drive bridges, panels to be installed



### What Neighbors Should Expect

- Pile driving, saw-cutting and other noise-producing work
- Occasional overnight bridge demolition
- General construction noise and other impacts
- Excavations across local roads with steel plates maintaining access
- Brief overnight closures of local bridges
- Periodic one-lane conditions on local roads with flaggers directing traffic in alternate directions








### What Motorists Should Expect

#### **Ongoing Traffic Impacts**

- Mid-day and overnight lane and shoulder closures
- Multi-lane closures and intermittent traffic stoppages on I-495 (Beltway) during overnight hours
- Lane shifts on I-495, new bridges, ramps and adjacent local roads

#### **Planned Extended Traffic Impacts**

- Georgetown Pike Interchange
  - Weekend long closure of bridge and ramps
  - Planned on or about summer 2024
  - Major outreach, marked detours
- Northbound I-495 near Tysons
  - Weekend long major lane reduction
  - Planned on or about fall 2024
  - Major outreach, marked detours



Typical afternoon congestion on northbound I-495 (October 2024)



## Georgetown Pike Bridge Construction Phases

- Building new bridge over I-495 in phases to keep traffic moving
- Final bridge configuration scheduled to open in late 2025







### Georgetown Pike Bridge Construction

- Place girders: late March/early April
- Install deck, barriers, signage and lane markings: spring/summer 2024
- Switch traffic onto new northern portion of bridge: summer 2024
  - Restore right-turn only lane from WB Georgetown Pike to NB I-495
- Demolish existing southern portion of bridge: late 2024
- Complete new southern portion of bridge: mid 2025
- Switch traffic onto final configuration of bridge: late 2025









### 495 NEXT Corridor Revegetation Conceptual Plan

#### **Clearing and Tree Removal**

Clearing began Summer 2022, 95% complete

#### **Revegetation Plan**

- Conceptual revegetation plan being developed by landscape architects
- Plant selection will focus on native, habitat-appropriate species
- Revegetation areas are primarily determined based on roadway/utility proximity and environmental limitations

#### **Plant Species Selection**

- Plant selections are categorized by habitat designation based on following criteria:
  - Safety
  - Roadway and Utility Features
  - Growth Habits





### Revegetation Design Considerations

#### **Safety**

- Ensure vegetation will not impact site distance for drivers or pedestrians
- Ensure vegetation will not impact structural integrity of slopes
- Ensure that mature trees will not block roadway if they fall

#### **Roadway/Utility Features**

- Ensure that plantings will not affect drainage patterns
- Provide for reasonable maintenance access
- Avoid conflicts with overhead and underground utilities


#### **Plant Species Selections**

- Match plant species to specific soil conditions (wet or dry)
- Select species that are tolerant of roadside conditions and weather treatments
- Consider growth patterns of species including mature heights and widths, and critical root zones
- Incorporate local native species





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

### 495 NEXT Revegetation Plan Next Steps

#### **Community Engagement**

 Work with local officials to conduct more focused discussions with interested community members on the conceptual revegetation plan

#### **Finalize Revegetation Plan**

Post final revegetation plan on the project website

#### Implement Revegetation Plan

- Factors affecting planting installation include, but are not limited to:
  - Completion of construction activities and final grading
  - Appropriate time of year
  - Weather conditions
  - Availability of plantings

### Mitigation Strategies Implemented at Georgetown Pike

- Monitoring and adjusting traffic signal timing at Georgetown Pike and Balls Hill Road
- Moved stop bar at Georgetown Pike and northbound I-495 ramp
- Repainted cross hatching at Georgetown Pike and Balls Hill Road intersection
- Funding and coordination with Fairfax County Police Department for increased on-site presence
- Supplemental Safety Service Patrol on I-495

### 495 NEXT Transportation Management Plan

# New commuter bus service between Tysons and Bethesda launching this summer

- Route 798 will be operated by Fairfax Connector
- Commonwealth committed \$5.2M for purchasing buses
- Transurban to provide \$2.2M per year for bus service operations
- Route will run on the 495 Express Lanes and over the American Legion Bridge

Carpool and vanpool incentives available through Commuter Connections and Vanpool Alliance

### George Washington Memorial Parkway (GWMP) Coordination

National Park Service (NPS) in partnership with Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) is rehabilitating the GWMP from Spout Run Parkway to I-495


- Major roadway construction

 VDOT continues to coordinate and collaborate with Maryland and Fairfax County to ensure best outcome for the public




